SUBJECT: **DRAFT SENSE OF THE BOARD ON POSSIBLE 2013 LEGISLATIVE ISSUES**

Background and Summary:

State Board of Health Policy 2001-001 outlines the Board's procedures for monitoring legislative activities, and communicating the Board's position on issues to the Legislature. The policy allows for the creation of a "Statement of Likely Legislative Issues" that describes the Board's general position on policy issues that may come before the Legislature. This document guides the activities of staff and individual Board members as issues arise during session. I have attached copies of both documents for discussion purposes.

Today, I will present a brief overview of the 90-day session that will begin January 14, 2013. The overview will be followed by an opportunity to review the 2012 sense of the Board document and discuss revisions Board members might like for the 2013 session. Comments from today's meeting, as well as any subsequent comments from Board members, will help staff propose a draft "Statement of Board Policy on Possible 2013 Legislative Issues" for this Board to consider and possibly adopt at its January 9, 2013 meeting.
