- Do not revise WAC § 246-203-130 regarding the Keeping of Animals, as proposed
  - Effective protection of public health depends upon retaining clear and specific requirements regarding the keeping of animals in populous districts
  - This law does not conflict with other agency rules or statutory authorities
  - Only the Department of Health is charged with protecting public health and public drinking water sources in accordance with the Safe Drinking Water Act
