It does not do what it was intended to do.

Small lodgings don't require this oversight and the HDs don't provide the service. HD permits mean nothing and mislead the Commissioners, Legislators, and citizens for they don't do their job or are so inconsistent its meaningless

It is no longer needed because:

WSDH cannot enforce this law so must require a 2nd HD to do the work so the business must then pay 2 HDs to do the work--state and county because it illogically refuses to accept the WSDAg commercial kitchen approval I require as a farm

It imposes unreasonable costs:

State HD cannot enforce this so it should not be able to impose its regulations on business--it can only "permit" housekeeping--not a requirement in the era of the internet--the public does it

The agency has no authority to make this rule:

On Bainbridge Island, I'm one of the smallest B&Bs and I'm the only one this law is being enforced on. Either it's important for everyone or one business should not be singled out for any reason

My business operates under an Approved Conditional Use Permit which has greater impact than anything the state HD can impose. This should be removed at the state level for it can't enforce it
