246-710	Coordinated children's Services	Review completed in September 2014. DOH recommends amending rules. Unclear at this time whether DOH or SBOH has some general authority to update rules.
246-760	Auditory and visual standards—School districts	Review of auditory rules completed July 2014. DOH recommends rules be amended. Review of visual acuity standards completed December 2014. DOH recommends rules be amended. Rulemaking currently in process.
