SUBJECT: UPDATE: GOVERNOR'S DIRECTIVE 16-06 SCHOOL RULES REVIEW

Background and Summary:

At its June meeting, the Department of Health (Department) briefed the Board on Governor's Directive 16-06 and Board staff provided historical information about the Board's School Environmental Health and Safety rules Chapter 246-366A WAC. The implementation of these rules has been suspended by a budget proviso since 2009. The Governor's Directive requires the Department to work with the Office of Financial Management and the Board to review the rule, and prepare a decision package to implement the school rule with an emphasis on implementing the portion of the rules related to lead exposure.

Today, Board staff will provide an update on the work to review the rule, and will describe the next steps in the process.
